Habitat International Coalition (HIC) is a global, independent, and non-profit network for the defense, promotion and realization of human rights related to habitat and a safe place to live in peace and with dignity, both in urban and rural areas.

HIC emerged from a civil society initiative at Habitat I, in 1976, and is a cross-regional coalition of civil society actors with shared values and objectives who come together to build cross-regional social force for systemic change in the areas of housing and land rights, social production of habitat, habitat and gender, and habitat and environment.





Members

HIC Members are civil society organizations, social movements, community-based or professional bodies, voluntary agencies, and research, scientific and educational institutions, who share the Coalition's objectives and values and expressing solidarity and support for local, regional and global struggles, engage in cross-regional political reflection and debate, and formulate joint strategies and advocacy actions. Members hold the highest decisionmaking authority in the Coalition, and through their right to vote can contribute to the overall strategy formulation of HIC and propose representatives to HIC's governing Board.
